

**DNA Board Resolution Regarding Proposed 2300 Naito Parkway Safe Rest  
Village  
12/13/2021**

Whereas the City of Portland (City) and Multnomah County (County) are planning to establish Safe Rest Villages to address the houseless crisis in our community;

Whereas the City/County have identified 2300 Naito Parkway as a site for a possible Safe Rest Village; and

Whereas 2300 Naito Parkway is located in the Portland Downtown Neighborhood Association (DNA); and

Whereas the DNA has reached out to organize a 2300 Naito Parkway Stakeholders Group to positively collaborate with the City/County in establishing 2300 Naito Parkway as a Safe Rest Village which can serve as a model for the city;

Be it resolved that the DNA fully supports the 2300 Naito Parkway Stakeholder Group as the legitimate voice of the downtown neighborhood in communicating with the county and the city on plans for the 2300 Naito Safe Rest Village; and

Be it further resolved that the DNA authorizes Darlene Garrett and David Dickson, co-chairs of the DNA Homeless/Houseless Team, to represent the DNA on the stakeholder group; and

Be it further resolved that policy positions taken by the Stakeholders Group are to be considered for approval by the DNA board before they are issued.
